B. INSTRUCTION FOR THE CANDIDATES

- a) Application form is to be filled-up on the university website, i.e., <u>www.awu.ac.in</u>.
- b) For programmes where entrance tests are not conducted, filled in application forms have to be submitted only after the declaration of final semester results of the qualifying examination.
- c) For under graduate and post graduate programmes for which entrance tests are to be conducted (subject to change as per Govt. notification), applicants awaiting their final results can also apply.
- d) Candidates shall have to appear before the Selection Committee as per Admission date, time and venue with all the original certificates, mark sheets, PRC and other supporting documents at their own cost.
- e) Candidates, if selected, shall have to take admission immediately after counselling. A candidate failing to take admission on the day shall have to forfeit the seat.
- f) Payment of fees has been waived for Academic Session 2020-2021, as per instructions given by Director of Higher Education, Govt. of Assam vide notification No. PC/HE/SOPD/11/2020/10 dated 17th June, 2020. However, Self-Financed Programmes like Master of Social Works (MSW), Master of Physiotherapy (MPT) and MA in Psychology are exempted from this Fee Waiver scheme.
- g) No separate call letters will be issued to the applicants.
