Introduction to the Workshop:

Barr. Balasaheb Khardekar Knowledge Resource Centre and Department of Library and Information Science, Shivaji University, Kolhapur in collaboration with INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar are going to conduct one week National Workshop for Library professionals on the topic “Creation and Management of IR using DSpace Open Source Software and Library Automation using SOUL 2.0”. The aim of the workshop is to provide training of creating IR using DSpace and to automate the library using SOUL 2.0 Library software. The workshop will provide theoretical as well as practical hands on training experience about DSpace & SOUL 2.0 software from the INFLIBNET experts.

Topics to be covered in Workshop:

- ✚ Institutional Repositories and Digital Libraries
- ✚ Linux and Basic Commands
- ✚ Metadata and Metadata Standards for Interoperability in IR
- ✚ DSpace: Installation, Configuration, Administration, Customization, Workflow, Submissions and Community Creation, Export/Import
- ✚ OAI-PMH and UNICODE
- ✚ IPR and Security aspects of IR, Hosting of IR
- ✚ Library Automation, SOUL 2.0: Features
- ✚ Database creation and digitization
- ✚ RFID Technology and Networking etc.

Objectives of the Workshop:

The objectives of the workshop are:

1. To provide knowledge about application of DSpace, Open Source Software to the participants.
2. To provide an idea about how to design and develop Institutional Repository (IR) and digital library using DSpace.
3. To train the participants to develop IR and digital library for their colleges and universities using DSpace with hands –on- training (Practicals).
4. To provide knowledge about the use of SOUL 2.0 Library Automation Software.
5. To provide practical hands on training on SOUL 2.0 library software.

6. To support LIS professionals for promotion from Stage II to Stage III under API/CAS point of view.

The Host:

Shivaji University, established in 1962, is named after the Great Maratha Warrior and founder of the Maratha Empire Chhatrapati Shivaji. It was inaugurated on 18th November, 1962 by Dr. Radhakrishnan, the then, President of India. The jurisdiction of the University is spread over three districts viz. Kolhapur, Sangli and Satara. In 1962, the University started functioning with 34 affiliated colleges and about 14000 students with 5 Post-graduate Departments on the campus. Today the number of affiliated colleges has reached up to 280 and students strength up to 3,00,000 with 40 Departments on campus. Shivaji University has been re-accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Bangalore, with "A" Grade (CGPA-3.16) (2014) which is highest in Maharashtra.

Barr. Balasaheb Khardekar Knowledge Resource Centre:

The Barr. Balasaheb Khardekar Knowledge Resource Centre, Shivaji University, Kolhapur is one of the leading university libraries in Southern Maharashtra, India. It caters to the academic needs of students, faculty and other user groups of university and visitors from other universities and institutes. The library has over 3.20 lakhs printed documents and it subscribes to over 283 national and international journals. Library is a member of e-ShodhSindhu consortium of INFLIBNET. Library gives access to over 6000+ electronic journals/databases. To cater the needs of differently abled students, library has developed ‘Resource Center for Inclusive Education’. For sharing of information, library undergoes contacts with different universities, national and international organizations/institutions.

Department of Library and Information Science:

The Department of Library and Information Science, Shivaji University, Kolhapur is one of the oldest department of Library Science in the Maharashtra. This department was started on 22 July, 1964 and had a history of fifty five years. Starting in the year 1964 with a Diploma Course in Library and Information Science, it

has come a long way upgrading the diploma to BLISc, starting MLISc of one year course (1985). The department also has to its credit Ph. D. program from 1990 onwards. To commemorate the 55th foundation day of the Department of Library & Information Science & Barr. Balasaheb Khardekar Knowledge Resource Centre, this workshop is being jointly organized.

INFLIBNET Centre:

Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre is an autonomous Inter-University Centre of the University Grants Commission (UGC) of India. It is a major National Programme initiated by the UGC in March 1991 now with its Head Quarter at Gandhinagar, Gujarat. Initially started as a project under the IUCAA, it became an independent Inter-University Centre in June 1996. INFLIBNET is involved in modernizing university libraries in India and connecting them as well as information centers in the country through a nation-wide high speed data network using the state-of-art technologies for the optimum utilization of information. INFLIBNET is set out to be a major player in promoting scholarly communication among academicians and researchers in India.

Importance and Relevance:

Developing institutional repository is essential and important for librarians so that the institutional resources can be accessed by anyone within and outside the institution. NAAC has made it mandatory for University and College libraries to automate their libraries with ILMS System but the librarians are lacking knowledge about how to computerize the library and to build the institutional repository and/ or create digital library for the benefit of students, teachers and researchers. The workshop will provide them all the essential training along with hands on practice for them. Further, it will contribute to the professional caliber and competence of the college librarians to deal with all types of resources, both print and electronic to make them globally accessible through digital library. Software for University Libraries (SOUL) is state-of-the-art Integrated Library Management Software designed and developed by the INFLIBNET Centre based on requirements of college and university libraries. The latest version 2.0 supports and provides various add on features. It is a user-friendly software developed to work

under client-server environment. The software is compliant to international standards for bibliographic formats, networking and circulation protocols. After a comprehensive study, discussions and deliberations with the senior professionals of the country, the software was designed to automate all house-keeping operations in library. The software is suitable for all types and sizes of libraries. The workshop provides an opportunity to the participants about practical use of SOUL 2.0 library software. Being a one week workshop cum training course, it also qualifies for claiming API as per UGC guidelines.

Registration Fees:

Participants from Colleges/Universities/Institutions has to deposit Rs.2000.00 as Registration fee which includes workshop kit, course material, breakfast, tea and working lunch (excluding accommodation and dinner). Interested participants have to register for this workshop on or before **18th July, 2018** by sending the requisite amount in the form of DD drawn in favour of **“Finance & Accounts Officer, Shivaji University, Kolhapur”**. Confirmation will be sent to all registered candidates by e-mail/telephone immediately. Registration will be final after paying requisite registration fees and duly filled in Registration Form. As the accommodation at SUK guest house is limited, participants are requested to book their accommodation as early as possible. No T.A/D.A will be paid to participants by the SUK.
