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<u>Information for Skill Test</u>

The skill test is conducted to broadly evaluate the competency of a candidate in the following aspects.

- 1. Subject knowledge and teaching ability
- 2. Communication Skills
- 3. Confidence and Poise
- 4. The candidate shall be evaluated on various aspects such as (among others)
 - a) Accuracy
 - b) Logical Thinking
 - c) Use of examples/illustrations
 - d) Time Management
 - e) Attitude
 - f) Creativity

The above Skill Test of the candidates shall be done in two stages as given below.

Stage 1: Group Discussion

(For Posts- TGT (Hindi/Sanskrit); TGT (Maths/Physics); TGT (Chemistry/Biology); Art Education Teacher; TGT (Physical & Health Education) (Female); Librarian; Primary Teacher; Primary Teacher (Music) only)

Group Discussion will be held for the candidates in a group of about 12 to 15 candidates in each group. It will be held in the first half of the day. Successful candidates in the Group Discussion have to attend the Skill Test in the Subject concerned in the second half of the day. In other words, candidates who get a 'GO' in Stage 2 will qualify to appear for stage '2' of skill test.

Stage 2: Test for Teaching Skills

5	PRT (Music)	The candidates have to perform (live) vocal or instrumental in front of the evaluation committee. Musical instruments (Tabla, Harmonium etc.) will be provided.	1) Presentation of subject matter – 10 minutes
6	PRT	The candidates have to do classroom teaching in the following areas: 1) Topics from the subject/discipline against which the candidate has applied pertaining to the NCERT syllabus, as applicable	Preparation for the classroom teaching – 10 minutes 2) Presentation of subject matter – 15 minutes
7	Prep. Teacher (No Group Discussion)	The candidates have to make a presentation/classroom teaching on a topic pertaining to: a) the ECCEd syllabus or equivalent as prescribed by the NCTE; and b) any open ended topic for creative thinking to be drawn/selected from the basket containing the cards/slips.	Preparation for the classroom teaching – 15 minutes Presentation of subject matter – 15 minutes

Note:

- 1. Topic for group discussion will be announced after entering the discussion room.
- 2. Topic Basket: It contains the cards/slips with topics to be drawn/selected from for presentation.
- 3. NCERT Books will be provided for preparation.
- 4. For candidates selected for Prep Teachers' skill test, there will not be Group Discussion.
